Attorney General Mark Brnovich announced a Pima County Grand Jury indicted Christy A. Randolph on kidnapping, theft, and vulnerable adult abuse charges.

It is alleged that Randolph stole more than \$10,000 while she was working as a caregiver for the victim and then moved him to Florida without permission to do so. The victim was found unharmed and is currently staying with a relative.
