As you may recall, the above-referenced defendant appealed his conviction and sentence to the Arizona Court of Appeals arguing that the trial court erred in ordering restitution without holding a hearing. The Court ruled in favor of the defendant and remanded the case back to the original trial court for a restitution hearing.

This letter is to inform you that the Restitution Hearing has been scheduled for **December 1, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** before the Honorable Kenneth Fields, Maricopa County Superior Court, East Court Building (ECB), Courtroom 411, 201 West Jefferson, Phoenix, Arizona 85003.

You have the lawful right to attend this hearing. However, you are not required to appear unless subpoenaed or requested by Assistant Attorney General Donald Conrad. It is common for court proceedings to be delayed or rescheduled for various reasons. Therefore, please contact our office one working day before the proceeding if you plan to attend.
